Inventing Food and Food Ways: Towards a Sustainable Model

Brief Abstract:

Various food movements around the world have aimed at cultivating foodways that enhance environmentally friendly food practices and food culture that enhance sustainable development. This idea of this project, sprung from my experiences in teaching the GE food course as well as my food waste research project with students during the summer in 2014, involves three dimensions: (i) learning and teaching; (ii) food and sustainability research; (iii) community engagement.
