
Workshop on the Science and Business of Biotechnology

Prof. Harvey F. Lodish is a Founding Member of the Whitehead Institute for Biomedical Research and Professor of Biology and Professor of Biological Engineering at the Massachusetts Institute of Technology.

He is a Member of the National Academy of Sciences and a Fellow of the American Academy of Arts and Sciences. Prof. Lodish is a member of the Board of Trustees of Boston Children's Hospital, where he is Chair of the Board of Trustees Resarch Committee. From 2008 to 2016 he was the

Founding Chair of the Scientific Advisory Board of the Massachusetts Life Sciences Center, the group charged with oversight of the state's 10- year \$1 billion investment in the life sciences. He was a founder and scientific advisory board member of several companies including Genzyme, Inc., and Millennium Pharmaceuticals, Inc., and has served on the scientific advisory boards of numerous biopharmaceutical companies.

This is a workshop to introduce the new types of drugs and other therapeutics in current practice and under development, the financing and business structures of early-stage biotechnology companies, and the evaluation of their risk/reward profiles. includes live case studies, focusing on the underlying science and engineering as well as core financing and business issues.
