<b>Headline :</b>	<b><i>Client Briefs, Control Plans and Tenders Endorsed</i></b>
<b>Content :</b>	<p>The following is issued on behalf of the Housing Authority:</p> <p>The Housing Authority's Building Committee today(Thursday) endorsed the proposed client briefs, control plans and project estimates for public housing developments at Tin Shui Wai Area 102 Phases One to Seven and Sau Mau Ping Estate Redevelopment Phase Seven.</p> <p>A spokesman for the Authority said the development at Tin Shui Wai Area 102 would produce 16 Concord blocks and five Harmony blocks, giving 9,072 flats in total.</p> <p>"The project of Sau Mau Ping Redevelopment Phase Seven includes a commercial centre with a total retail area of 12,500 square meter, an estate management office and car parking and community facilities," he said.</p> <p>Meanwhile, members also endorsed the tenders for the construction of Kwai Shing East Estate Redevelopment Phase Two and the construction of Wan Tsui Estate Redevelopment (HOS).</p> <p>"The works at Kwai Shing East Estate Redevelopment Phase Two includes constructing two 39-storey Harmony One blocks providing a total of 1,518 domestic flats," he said.</p> <p>"The project of Wan Tsui Estate Redevelopment (HOS) comprises the construction of one 35-storey New Cruciform block providing 353 flats and one 2-storey carpark providing 39 parking spaces," he said.</p> <p>Also endorsed were tenders for lift and electrical installation for Tseung Kwan O Area 59 Phases Five and Six, and rewiring and reinforcement of electrical installation for all the nine blocks at Fuk Loi Estate and all the eight blocks at Lai Kok Estate.</p> <p>Tenders for the replumbing at Choi Wan Estate (II) and the escalator installation for Heng On Shopping Centre were also approved.
