Headline :	<i>Naming Public Housing Facilities After Donors</i>
Content :	<p>The following is issued on behalf of the Housing Authority:</p> <p>Donors of the Community Chest may choose to have their names inscribed on public housing estate facilities for donations of not less than \$5 million.</p> <p>At a meeting today (Thursday), the Housing Authority endorsed a proposal for naming facilities after donors of the Chest.</p> <p>"This idea not only helps the Community Chest raise funds for various social welfare services but also instills a strong sense of community involvement." a Housing Department spokesman said.</p> <p>As a start, a donor's name may be inscribed on murals, water features or sound barriers within an open area in rest gardens of new public housing estates.</p> <p>The scheme is expected to be launched before June 30.</p> <p>"The naming right will last for as long as the estate exists but will not be transferred to another estate upon redevelopment,"the spokesman said.
