Headline :	<i>Tenders for Infill Site Construction Endorsed</i>
Content :	<p>The following is issued on behalf of the Housing Authority:</p> <p>The Housing Authority's Building Committee today (Thursday) endorsed the tenders for the construction of housing at Wan Tsui Estate Infill Site and Shek Lei Estate Extension Infill Site.</p> <p>The work at Wan Tsui Estate Infill Site includes the construction of one 19-storey Small Household block. This will provide 143 one person/two persons units, eight one person/two persons wheelchair units, 33 two-bedroom units and an Estate Liaison Office for the elderly.</p> <p>The construction at Shek Lei Estate Extension Infill Site is for Home Ownership Scheme development. The project includes two 36-storey New Cruciform blocks, providing 700 flats and a 3-storey carpark podium with 214 parking spaces.</p> <p>Committee members also approved the tender for the construction of redevelopment of Tin Wan Estate Phase Three. The project includes a 3-storey Housing for Senior Citizens block providing 126 hostel bedroom units, a 5-storey commercial centre providing more than 9,000 square meter floor area, and a 4-storey car park providing 324 parking spaces.</p> <p>The tender for the construction of Tseung Kwan O Area 59 Phase Seven was also endorsed. The work includes the construction of a 4-storey commercial centre and two covered footbridges connecting to Phases Five and Six.</p> <p>Also approved in the meeting was the scheme design for the Home Ownership Scheme development at an infill site at Wang Tau Hom Estate Phase 13. The scheme design includes the construction of a 38-storey New Cruciform block with 370 flats above a 2-storey carpark podium providing 112 parking spaces. End Thursday, May 16, 1996</p>
