Born in Vietnam and grew up in Sydney, Australia. Mr Phung obtained his Bachelor and Masters degrees in Forensic Psychology at the University of New South Wales. Mr Phung's varied work experience included being a hospitality manager in a restaurant chain, an Intern Psychologist at the Family Court, and a Workers' Rehabilitation Consulting Psychologist specializing in assisting injured workers. Prior to joining the Community College of City University in 2006, he worked for six years for the Department of Corrective Services in New South Wales working with inmates with various charges and convictions.
