

**City University of Hong Kong**  
**Scholarships for International Students (for 2013/14 Entry)**

Name of Scholarship: The Department of Media and Communication Scholarships for  
International Students (UGC-funded Undergraduate Students)

Terms and Conditions:

1. The scholarships are tenable for a maximum of four years or until the completion of the undergraduate programme as enrolled by the student, whichever is the shorter period. The scholarship may be suspended for any period when the student is absent from the University, such as enrolling in a job placement scheme or other interruption.
2. The scholarship is automatically renewed each year on condition that the student achieves a Cumulative Grade Point Average (CGPA) at 3.2 or above by the end of Semester B each year and he/she enrolls in the same program of study throughout the award period.
3. Should the student fail to achieve a CGPA at 3.2 by the end of Semester B each year for scholarship renewal, a grace period of one-semester in the following academic year (i.e. Semester A), will be granted. However, should his/her CGPA by the end of Semester A of the following academic year be lower than 3.2, the scholarship will automatically be terminated with effect from the commencement date of Semester B in that academic year.
4. The Scholarships shall be offered in terms of waiver of full or half of the tuition fee for the year concerned. No cash shall be paid to the recipient.
5. The student is liable to pay all other expenses, such as student residence fee and fees that the University may charge from time to time.
6. The student is required to pay all expenses to attend any workshops, studies or training during summer.
7. The student has to abide by the laws of the HKSAR and the rules and regulations of the University.
8. The maximum number of awards per annum is 3.

Remark:

With an objective to nurture our students and to promote caring culture, the Community Relations Committee of the University Council has recommended that each award recipient is expected to make an annual donation of at least HK\$200 to City University of Hong Kong for student support via CityU Alumni Giving Club when they are in employment after graduation. This term has been incorporated into all scholarship/prize/award/bursary schemes, whether they are donated by external donors or contributed by University funding, with effect from February 2008.
