Technical Seminar on “The Asian Games Facilities, Guangzhou 2010”

Programme Highlights

To prepare for the Asian Games in November 2010, the Guangzhou Municipal Government has finalized the planning scheme for the overall provisions for the Asian Games facilities back in mid 2007. In the approved scheme, a new centre known as the Asian Games Town at Puyu comprising the Athletes' Village, the Main Media Centre, the Logistics Area, the Gymnasium Complex, and the Asian Games Park, are the main facilities newly constructed for the purpose. Besides, more than 10 major existing facilities including the Guangdong Olympic Stadium, Guangzhou Gymnasium, Guangdong People's Stadium, or other facilities in Guangzhou Higher Education Mega Centre, are renovated or upgrading to meet the demands of the upcoming Asian game sports. Making use of the same opportunity, Guangzhou has also integrated the planning of the Games venues and the associated facilities with the “Guangzhou City Development Strategy 2020”, which is a master plan targets for the development of Guangzhou into a contemporary mega-city and the regional centre in the coming decades. This talk is aimed to provide an overview of the said development with an overall description to highlight what is being done in Guangzhou towards this target.
