

# Procedures of using CityU WLAN service inside the CityU campus

This manual helps you set up your notebook computer to access the Internet via the CityU WLAN service. You should have the following items:

- Windows 7 installed in the notebook computer
- Built-in or an external wireless network interface card (IEEE 802.11a, b, g or n compatible)
- Network connection password

## Step 1: Wireless Network Card Installation

a) If your computer has a built-in WLAN card, the bundled Windows 7 should recognize it and you may skip to step 2.

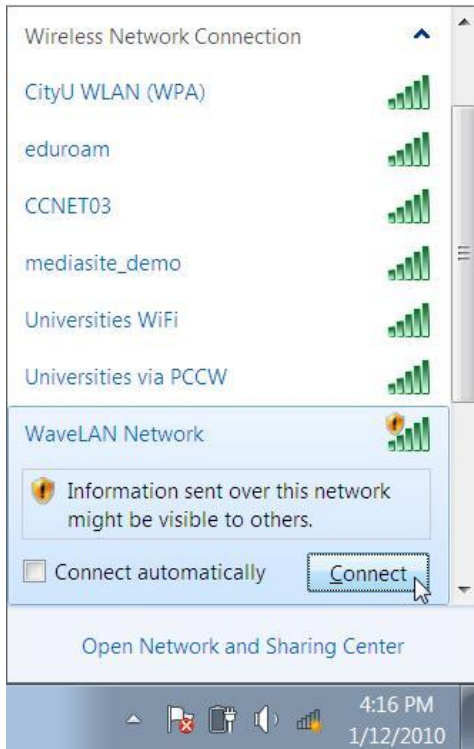
b) If you are using an external WLAN card, you can insert your WLAN interface card into the computer.

c) Turn on the computer and Windows 7 will detect the card and install the driver automatically.

If you are using a WLAN card that is not recognized and supported by Windows 7 natively, you may install the driver manually. Please follow the steps described in the installation guide that comes with your WLAN card.

## Step 2: Connecting to CityU WLAN

a) Click on the "**Wireless Network icon**" in the System Tray to list the available wireless network in range and then select the "**WaveLAN Network**" network and click the "**Connect**" button to establish connection.



## Step 2: Login via the web browser

1. Bring up your favorite web browser and visit any web page. If you are not yet authenticated, the system will forward you to the login page:



2. Enter your CityU EID and network connection password and then press the "Log In" button. You may enjoy free Internet access upon successful logon.
