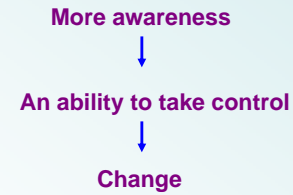

Electronic learning portfolios engage students in reflection on their learning.

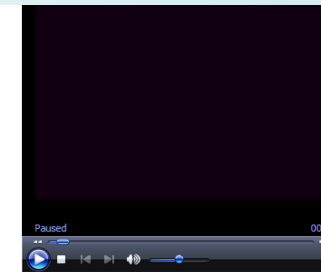


Three examples:
