

## Findit@CityU in Google Scholar

### What is Google Scholar?

Google Scholar (<http://scholar.google.com>) is a free search tool that specializes in locating scholarly materials (e.g. journal articles, books, theses, reports, patents, court opinions) across many disciplines and sources (e.g. academic publishers, professional societies, online repositories and universities).

### What is the “Findit@CityU” link?

Full-text access to many of the articles/books found by Google Scholar searches requires paid subscription. Often, you will be denied access or asked to pay when you try to view the full text of a citation in the search results, especially when you are off campus. The “Findit@CityU” links in Google Scholar link your search results to CityU Library’s subscriptions via SFX. They tell you whether online articles are available within the Library’s subscriptions and, if the articles are available, they allow you to access them both on and off campus.

The “Findit@CityU” link appears next to an article record when full text is available from the Library. Click on the link to access the full text via SFX.

## How to set up the “Findit@CityU” link?

### On campus:

At PCs on campus, no configuration is required. The “Findit@CityU” links will automatically appear in your Google Search results.

### Off campus:

Simple setting of Scholar Preferences is required:

- In Google Scholar, click **Scholar Preferences**.
- Enter “cityu” in the “Library Links” search box.
- Click the **Find Library** button.
- Select **City University of Hong Kong Library - Findit@CityU**.
- Click the **Save Preferences** button.

### N.B.

If you have a personal RefWorks account, you may also set up the “Import into RefWorks” links in Scholar Preferences. The link will appear under each record in your search results.

**Bibliography Manager**  Don't show any citation import links.  
 Show links to import citations into **RefWorks**

Save your preferences when finished and return to search.
