



## Project MUSE

**Project MUSE** provides access to over 300 Library-subscribed e-journals published by a number of scholarly publishers, covering the fields of literature and criticism, history, cultural studies, education, political science, economics, and many others.

### Access

1. At the Library Home Page (<http://www.cityu.edu.hk/lib/>), select the Databases tab.
  2. Select **Project MUSE** from the alphabetical list.
- OR
1. At the Library Home Page (<http://www.cityu.edu.hk/lib/>), click on Electronic Resources.
  2. Select E-Journals: Featured Collections.
  3. Select **Project MUSE** from the alphabetical list.

### Search

1. Enter search term(s).  
Use Boolean operators (AND, OR, NOT) to combine terms, if desired.

### Display Results

- 1 Gives indication of whether the full-text of the search result can be accessed.
- 2 Click to modify your search .e.g. to modify search terms, to add more search terms or to change Boolean operators.
- 3 Select a different sort format, if desired. Other options include date descending or date ascending
- 4 Select to limit search to full text only.
- 5 Select to limit search by *Research Area* or by *Author*
- 6 Click to display the article in HTML / PDF format.

## Search Tips

- Phrase Searching: enclose the phrase in quotation marks.  
e.g. "life after death"

- Boolean Operators:

| <b>Operator</b> | <b>Example</b>                | <b>Finds articles containing...</b>                                |
|-----------------|-------------------------------|--|
| and             | education <b>and</b> internet | <i>education</i> and <i>internet</i> in the specified fields       |
| or              | web <b>or</b> internet        | <i>web</i> or <i>internet</i> , or both, in the specified fields   |
| not             | education <b>not</b> internet | <i>education</i> , but not <i>internet</i> in the specified fields |

- Truncation Symbol:

The truncation symbol (\*) can be used to substitute any number of characters following a word root.  
e.g., enter *modern*\* will find *modern*, *modernity* and *modernism*

- The search engine combines the Boolean operators from *left to right*. You may use parentheses to specify the order of execution of the Boolean operations in your search statement. Terms inside the parentheses are given precedence.  
e.g. **education and (web or internet)**
- When punctuation or characters (including ampersands) appear as parts of words, enter the punctuation or character, or leave a space and enclose in quotation marks.  
e.g. **non-violence** or "**non violence**" retrieves *non-violence*

### **Print / Download the Full-Text Articles**

To print or download a HTML full-text article, use the browser's **Print/Save As** function.

To print or download a PDF full-text article, click the **Print** or **Save a Copy** button of the Adobe Reader.

### **Journal Alerts**

You can sign up to receive information of new journal issues or new titles available in Project MUSE via email notifications or RSS Feeds.
