

Downloading NetLibrary e-Books to Your Pocket PC / Palm

Downloadable NetLibrary e-Books

Some, not all, NetLibrary e-books (about 17,800 titles) are downloadable to your Pocket PC or Palm for offline reading anywhere you like. You will find “*Checkout & Download this eBook*” as a viewing option if a NetLibrary e-book is downloadable and readable on a mobile device such as Pocket PC and Palm.

Prepare your PC and Pocket PC/Palm to Download and View e-Books

To view NetLibrary e-books on your Pocket PC or Palm, you need to do the following preparation works:

Step 1: Install Adobe Reader 6.0 or above in your PC

Adobe Reader 6.0 or above is required to download NetLibrary e-books to your PC. To get the software:

1. Go to <http://www.adobe.com>
2. Click on **Get Adobe Reader** icon.
3. Download the version appropriate for the operating system of your PC

Step 2: Download Adobe Reader for Pocket PC/Palm

1. Download Adobe Reader for Pocket PC / Palm
 - i) Go to <http://www.adobe.com>
 - ii) Click on **Get Adobe Reader** icon
 - iii) Click on **Adobe Reader for mobile devices**.
 - iv) Download the version appropriate for your mobile device
2. Sync the Adobe Reader to your Pocket PC / Palm

Step 3: Activate Adobe Readers on Adobe DRM Activator

1. On your PC, open **Adobe Reader**
 - For Adobe Reader 6.0, select from top menu: **Tools > Ebook Web Services > Adobe DRM Activator**
 - For Adobe Reader 7.0, select from top menu: **File > Digital Editions > Authorize Devices**
2. Sign in to the Adobe DRM Activator



Click on the **Sign In** button if you have a .NET Passport

Click on **Sign up for a .NET Passport** if you have not got one.

N.B.

You may be prompted to create your **personal Activation Profile** if it is your first time signing in to Adobe DRM Activator. Just follow the instructions on screen to create your profile.

Create Your Activation Profile

The next step in activating Adobe Reader or Acrobat is to create a personal Activation Profile containing your name and a valid email address. Identifying yourself in this way makes it possible for you to activate Adobe Reader or Acrobat on multiple computers or mobile devices and share Digital Editions among them without purchasing additional copies.

Please Note: For your convenience, some or all of the fields in this form have been filled in with data from your .NET Passport. By clicking Create Profile, you authorize Adobe to save this information as part of your Activation Profile. Adobe will handle this information according to the [Adobe Privacy Policy](#).

3. Activate Adobe Readers in your PC and Pocket PC/Palm

Activate Adobe Reader or Acrobat

Activate Adobe Reader or Acrobat on this computer by clicking the button below.

Activate Adobe Reader on Your Palm OS or Pocket PC Device

Activate Adobe Reader on your Palm OS or Pocket PC device by clicking the appropriate button below. You must have Adobe Reader for Palm OS or Adobe Reader for Pocket PC installed on this computer and on your mobile device.

After successful sign in, click on the **Activate** button to activate the Adobe Reader in your PC.

For Adobe Reader 7.0, this step is performed automatically.

Please Wait. Activation of Adobe Reader or Acrobat on your Computer is starting now.

Within a few moments, you should see Adobe Reader or Acrobat start on your computer to continue the activation process. Please be patient, as this may take a few minutes.

If activation does not start within two minutes, please [click here](#).

If a **File Download security message** appears, this is your browser warning you that a file is being downloaded. This is normal, and you should respond in Microsoft Internet Explorer by clicking the Open button at the bottom of the message. If you are using Netscape, select the "Open Using..." option and click OK.

If your browser asks you which application to use to open the downloaded file, you have not properly installed Adobe Reader or Acrobat version 6 or later. Please cancel the download and install one of these products.

If activation fails or you do not allow the browser to open the downloaded activation file, Adobe Reader or Acrobat will not be activated. In this case, you should click the Back button on your browser and, if desired, repeat the activation.

After activation completes, use the button below to view your current activations, or you may log out or close your browser.

After successful activation, click the **Return to Activation Page** button.

Activate Adobe Reader or Acrobat

Activate Adobe Reader or Acrobat on this computer by clicking the button below.

Activate Adobe Reader on Your Palm OS or Pocket PC Device

Activate Adobe Reader on your Palm OS or Pocket PC device by clicking the appropriate button below. You must have Adobe Reader for Palm OS or Adobe Reader for Pocket PC installed on this computer and on your mobile device.

Click on the **Activate Pocket PC Device** button or the **Activate Palm OS Device** button to activate the Adobe Reader on your mobile device.

Transfer e-Books to Your Pocket PC/Palm

Step 1: Download the e-book

Important!

For security reasons, **DO NOT** download and sync NetLibrary e-books to mobile devices on public PC. You are recommended to do so on your own PC only.

On your PC

- you may find NetLibrary ebooks by searching in:
 - Library Catalogue (<http://lib.cityu.edu.hk>)
 - NetLibrary (path: Library Home → Electronic Resources → E-Books → [Search the Collection](#) under “NetLibrary Electronic Books”)
- When you come across a NetLibrary e-book with the option **Check Out & Download this eBook**, that e-book can be transferred to your Pocket PC/Palm for offline reading.

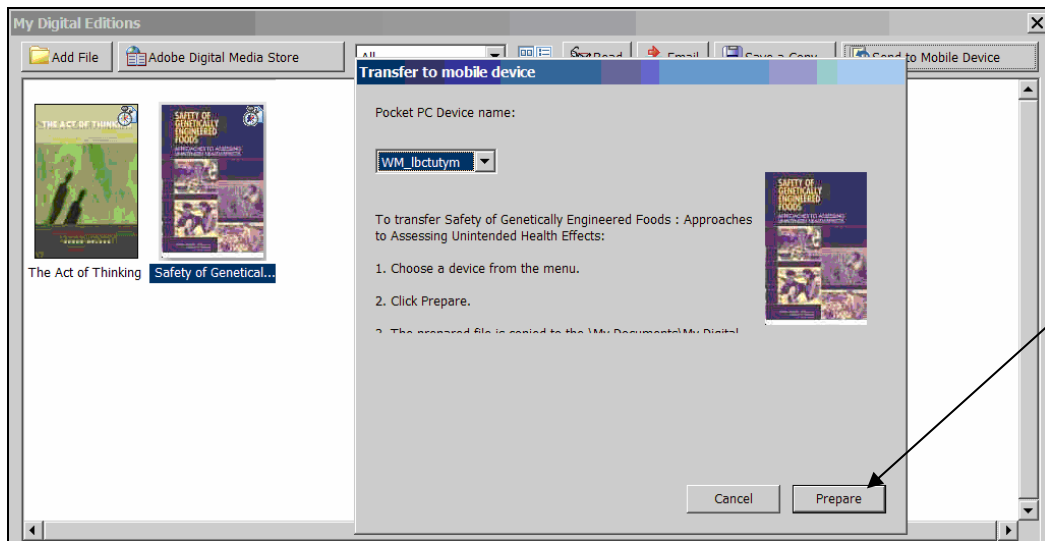
1. Click on **Check Out & Download this eBook**.
2. Log in your personal NetLibrary account. (If you have not set up your NetLibrary account, click on **Create a Free Account** in the top right corner.)
3. Click on **Download this eContent** button.
4. Close the downloaded e-book.

Step 2: Transfer the e-book to your Pocket PC/Palm

On your PC

1. Open **Adobe Reader**
2. For Adobe Reader 6.0, select from top menu: **File > My Bookshelf**
For Adobe Reader 7.0, select from top menu: **File > Digital Editions > My Digital Editions**

6. **Sync** the e-book to your Pocket PC/Palm

Step 3: View e-book on your Pocket PC/Palm

On your Pocket PC

1. Tap on the **Adobe Reader** icon.
2. From the list of e-books, tap on the desired e-book title.

To change to another e-book, tap on the folder icon on the bottom left corner to return to the list of e-books.

Loan Period and Quota for Pocket PC/Palm-readable netLibrary e-Books

The loan period for pocket PC/Palm-readable ebooks is **1 day**. When the e-book expires, you will need to check out and download the e-book again if you still need the e-book.

A maximum of **5 downloadable e-books** can be checked out and transferred to your Pocket PC/Palm at a time.

When you do not need the e-book anymore before it expires, please follow the steps below to check it in so that it can be released to other users:

1. Go to NetLibrary.
2. Click on **Checked Out Items** at the top right corner of the screen.
3. Log in your personal NetLibrary account.
4. You will see a list of your checked out items. Click on **Check In** under the e-book to be returned.
