**About Oxford Journals Online**

Oxford Journals Online is a multi-disciplinary e-journal collection that provides full-text access to almost 200 Library-subscribed journals published by **Oxford University Press**.

**Access**

1. At the Library Homepage (<http://www.cityu.edu.hk/lib/>), select **E-Resources**.
2. Select **E-Journals: Featured Collections**.
3. Select **Oxford Journals Online**.
4.
  - To browse the e-journals,
    - a. click on JOURNALS A-Z to select from the complete list of journal titles, or
    - b. select the desired title from the scroll list and click on the button JOURNAL HOME PAGE, or
    - c. click on the desired subject under JOURNALS BY SUBJECT to view a list of corresponding journal titles.
  - To search for journal articles, click on the hyperlink **Advanced search**.

**Search**

1. Enter the year and/or volume and starting page number in the **Citation** search box to locate the desired article.  
 OR  
 Enter keywords or phrases to search within article titles / abstract / text.  
 OR  
 Enter name(s) of author(s).
3. [Optional] Select journal(s) or a subject area to search. To select multiple journals, hold down the <Ctrl> key and select the desired items.
4. Specify a date range, if desired.
2. Click to start search.

Full title or fragments of a title, or phrases should be enclosed in quotation marks.

**Search Tips**

- Search by Citation box takes precedence over the Keywords or Authors box, so an invalid citation in the Citation search box will return no articles even if there is a valid citation in the Keywords or Authors search boxes. If you are not sure about the accuracy of the citation details, do the search by article title/phrase or author(s).

- To search for a phrase, enclose the phrase in quotation marks, e.g. "human genome".
- All fields in either box are connected with an AND expression, while words in a field in a specific box are connected by OR.
- Use the wildcard symbol (\*) to find all words that contain a particular root word.  
Examples: entering **environment\*** will find *environment, environmental, environmentally*, etc.  
entering **vaccin\*** will find *vaccines, vaccination, etc.*

**Boolean Operators:**

<i>Operator</i>	<i>Example</i>	<i>Finds articles containing...</i>
AND	molecular <b>and</b> cloning	<i>molecular and cloning</i>
OR	web <b>or</b> internet	<i>web or internet, or both</i>
NOT	genetic <b>not</b> engineering	<i>genetic, but not engineering</i>

- Use parentheses to specify the order of execution of the Boolean/Proximity operations in your search statement.  
e.g. brain and (serotonin or dopamine)  
*Order of execution:*
  - (serotonin or dopamine) → [result set #1]
  - brain and [result set #1]

**Display Search Results**

**Print/Download the Full-Text Articles**

To print/download a HTML full-text article, use the browser's **Print/Save As** function.  
To print/download a PDF full-text article, click on the **Print/Save a Copy** button of the Adobe Reader.
