Access

2. Select **Wiley Online Library** from the alphabetical list of databases.


Search

★ Search Tips ★

- To search for a **phrase**, enclose the phrase in quotation marks, e.g. **"human genome"**
- Use the **truncation symbol** (*) to find all words that contain a particular root word.
Examples: entering environment* will find environment, environmental, environmentally, etc.
- Boolean and Proximity Operators:

Operator	Example	Finds articles containing...
AND	molecular AND cloning	<i>molecular and cloning</i>
OR	web OR internet	<i>web or internet, or both</i>
NOT	genetic NOT engineering	<i>genetic, but not engineering</i>

◆ **Boolean operators** must be typed in **capital letters**.

- Use **parentheses** to specify the order of execution of the Boolean/Proximity operations in your search statement.
e.g. brain and (serotonin or dopamine)
Order of execution:
1. (serotonin or dopamine) → [result set #1]
2. brain and [result set #1]



Display Search Results

Click to Save Search into a personal account.

Click to filter results by Publication Type, Publication Date, Access Status, Subjects, Published in and Authors.
