**Access**

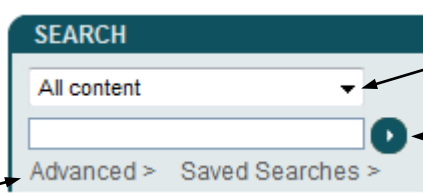
1. At the Library Home Page (<http://www.cityu.edu.hk/lib/>), select the **Databases** tab.
2. Select **Wiley Online Library** from the alphabetical list.

**OR**

2. Click on Featured Collections under **E-Journals**
3. Select **Wiley Online Library** from the alphabetical list.

**Search**

1. Enter search term(s)  
(Multiple words entered will be automatically combined with the AND operator)



2. Select to search by: All content or Publication titles.
3. Click to start Search

Select Advanced Search for complex search queries.

**Advanced Search**

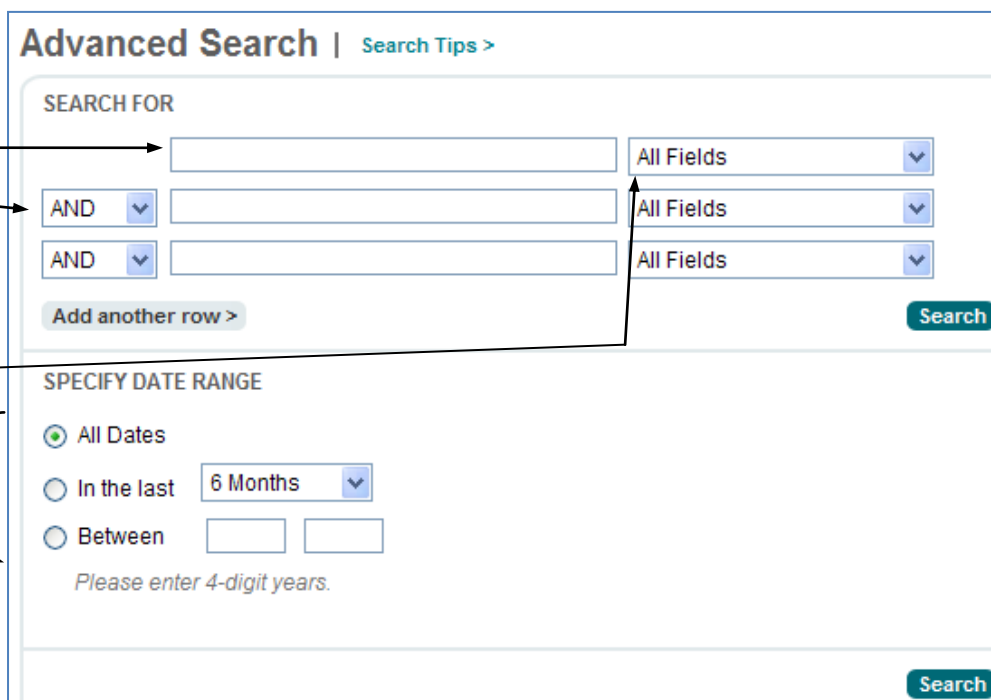
1. Enter search term(s)  
(Multiple words entered will be automatically combined with the AND operator)

2. Select an operator to combine the search terms in different fields

3. Select the field to search

4. Specify a date range

5. Click **Search** to start.



## Search Tips

- To search for a phrase, enclose the phrase in quotation marks, e.g. "human genome"
- Use the truncation symbol (\*) to find all words that contain a particular root word.  
Examples: entering environment\* will find *environment, environmental, environmentally*, etc.  
entering \*conductors will find *conductors, semiconductors, and superconductors*.
- Boolean and Proximity Operators:
 

Operator	Example	Finds articles containing...
AND	molecular <b>and</b> cloning	<i>molecular and cloning</i>
OR	web <b>or</b> internet	<i>web or internet, or both</i>
NOT	genetic <b>not</b> engineering	<i>genetic, but not engineering</i>
- Use parentheses to specify the order of execution of the Boolean/Proximity operations in your search statement.  
e.g. brain and (serotonin or dopamine)  
*Order of execution:*  
1.(serotonin or dopamine) → [result set #1]  
2. brain and [result set #1]

## Display Search Results

**Annotations:**

- Click to Export citations to reference management software e.g. RefWorks:** Points to the "Export Citation" button.
- Click to make changes to your current search:** Points to the "Edit search" button.
- Click to save search terms to a personal account.\*:** Points to the "Save search" button.
- Select to Sort by: Best Match or Date:** Points to the "Sort by" dropdown menu.
- Click to limit search results to journals only:** Points to the "Journals (2)" filter option in the "FILTER LIST".
- Click to display the abstract of the article. Click to display the list of references used in the article.** Points to the "Abstract" and "References" links for the second article.
- Check boxes to mark items for later viewing / printing / emailing:** Points to the checkboxes next to the article titles.
- Indicates fulltext is available:** Points to the lock icon next to the article titles.
- Save search results to personal account\*:** Points to the "Save to profile" button.
