
Electronic ID (EID)

To facilitate your access to all the IT facilities and services of the University, a single unified electronic ID (EID) has been assigned to you during your study at CityU.


Once you have set up a password for your EID, you can login to your e-mail account, e-Portal and other network facilities of the University immediately. For system security, you are advised to change your password from time to time.

e-Portal

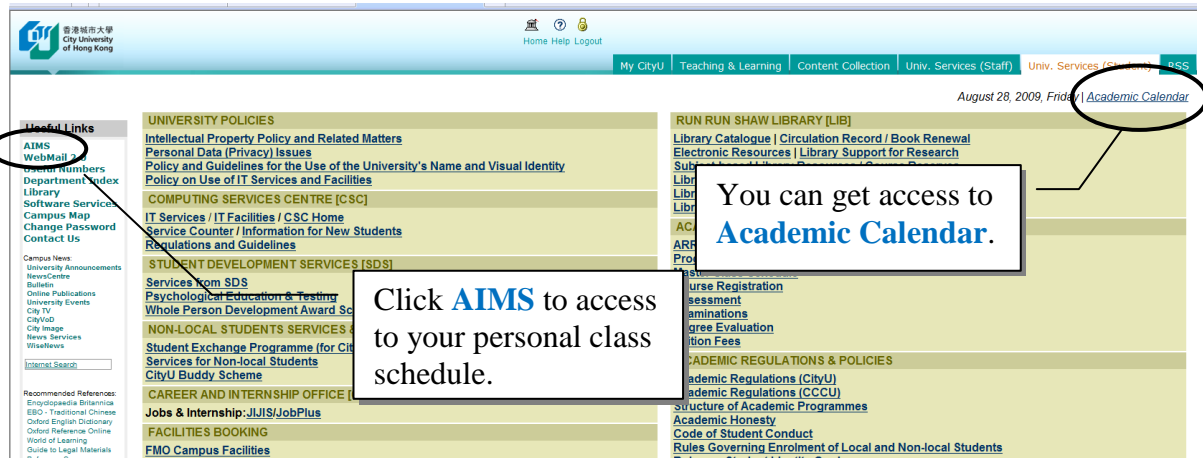

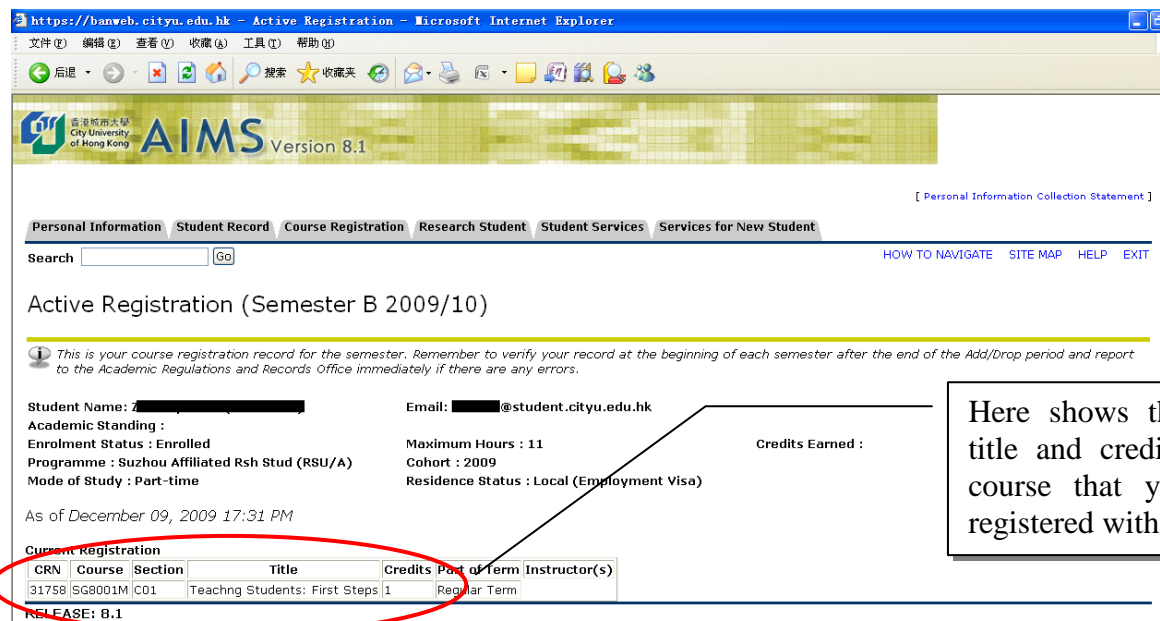
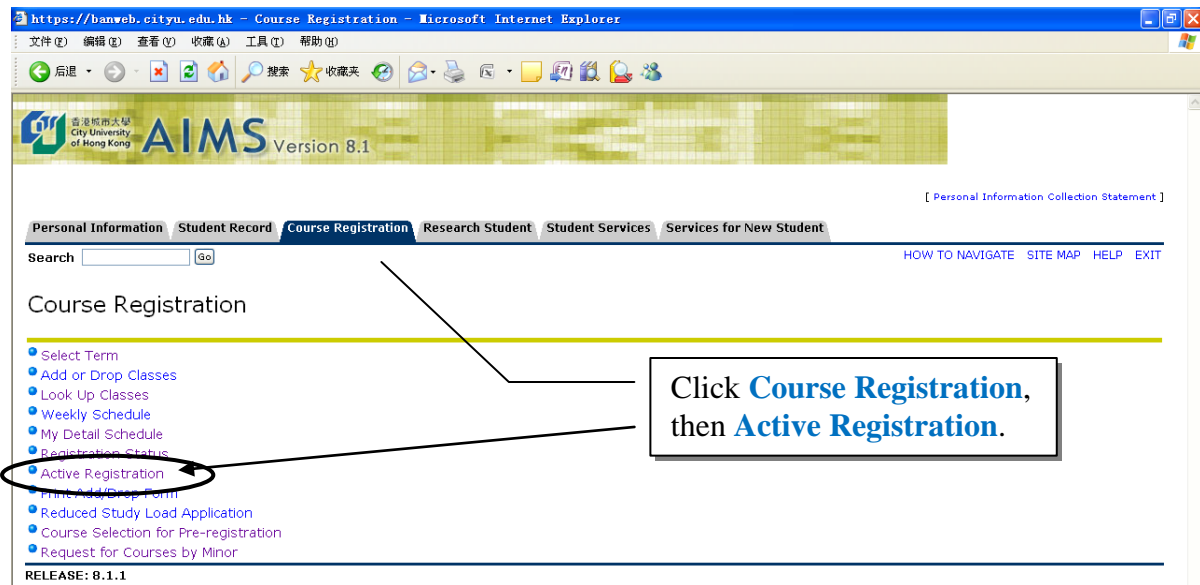
