The Scholarship is offered to commend students for their outstanding academic achievements in the Hong Kong Diploma of Secondary Examination (HKDSE) and to recognize the contributions of construction workers to the development of Hong Kong society while nurturing their next generations.

Eligibility	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • A candidate of the 2020 HKDSE who attains a minimum of level 3 for Chinese Language1 and English Language and level 2 for Mathematics and Liberal Studies (i.e. “3322”). • A Hong Kong resident. • At least one of the applicant’s parents, legal guardians or siblings must be A) currently engaged in “construction work” . Those carrying out non-construction works on construction sites (e.g. site clerk, security guard, site management, etc.) will not be considered. The CIC may request for relevant information regarding the construction work carried out for verification; and B) a registered construction worker with <u>valid registration on/before 30 June 2020</u> and the registration is still valid on the dates of the submission of the application form and the scholarships award presentation ceremony. • The applicant’s parents/legal guardians/siblings must not be a full-time employee of Construction Industry Council.
