

## **Sir Edward Youde Memorial Overseas Fellowship / Scholarship for Disabled Students 2021/22**

The Sir Edward Youde Memorial Fund is offering an award of Fellowship / Scholarship to finance one outstanding disabled student in Hong Kong for overseas studies commencing in the 2021/22 academic year.

Value of Awards	<p>The maximum value of award are:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>a. Fellowship: HK\$300,000 per year</li> <li>b. Scholarship: HK\$280,000 per year</li> </ol> <p>The Sir Edward Youde Memorial Fund Council may adjust downward the value of the fellowship/scholarship by taking into account the actual university fees, necessary living expenses and other award(s) held concurrently by the fellow / scholar to finance his / her overseas studies.</p>
Eligibility	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>a. An applicant for the Fellowship must: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- be a permanent resident of Hong Kong;</li> <li>- have received at least 7 years of continuous full-time education in Hong Kong;</li> <li>- be responsible for fulfilling all application procedures and admission requirements at the institution of his / her choice and be offered a place subsequently;</li> <li>- hold a good Honours degree obtained in Hong Kong or equivalent qualification OR expects to obtain such a degree or equivalent qualificator before 31 December 2021; and</li> <li>- have a good mastery of the language in which his / her studies will be undertaken.</li> </ul> </li> <li>b. An applicant for the Scholarship must: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- be a permanent resident of Hong Kong;</li> <li>- have received at least 5 years of continuous full-time education in Hong Kong;</li> <li>- be responsible for fulfilling all application procedures and admission requirements at the institution of his / her choices and be offered places subsequently; and</li> <li>- have a good mastery of the language in which their studies will be undertaken.</li> </ul> </li> </ol> <p>The applicants (for both the Fellowship and Scholarship) should have special educational needs as referred to in the Hong Kong Rehabilitation Programme Plan released by the Hong Kong Special Administrative Region Government and / or mental health needs.</p>
Application Deadline	5:30 p.m. on 18 September 2020 (Friday). Late applications will be not considered.
