Eligibility	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Only open to ethnic minority (Non-Chinese) residents in Hong Kong with right of abode and holding a valid HK Identity Card. Persons holding study, travel or visit visa are NOT eligible to apply. • Only first-year students are eligible to apply for the scholarships. • Students who will graduate from Form 6 in July 2023. • Students who are enrolled in a full-time degree or sub-degree program offered by higher education institutions in Hong Kong in the 2023/24 academic year. • (For merit-based Tertiary Education Scholarship) Students must be in good academic standing. • (For financial need-based Tertiary Education Scholarship) Students must demonstrate a need for financial assistance. • (For Chinese Performance Scholarship) Students who attain at least Level 2 in HKDSE Chinese / at least B in GCE (AL) Chinese / at least grade 5 in IB Mandarin (SL) / at least grade 4 in IB Chinese B (HL).
