The Li Kwan Hung Education Fund 2023/2024 is intended to assist students with disabilities studying with their able-bodied counterparts in local educational institutes at various levels.

Scholarship Value	Based on the level of study and the nature of disability of the applicant, a grant could be considered for the following eligible items. The grant for each applicant will normally not exceed \$5,000. The amount for each grantee will depend on his/her financial situation and need, as well as the number of grantees approved by the Association's Finance Committee.
Eligibility	<ol> <li>Applicant should meet all the following criteria:</li> <li>Hong Kong permanent residents;</li> <li>students with physical disabilities, intellectual disabilities, special educational needs (SENs) (including autism / attention deficit and hyperactivity disorder / dyslexic), chronic illness, visual impairment or hearing impairment;</li> <li>full-time students studying with their able-bodied counterparts in local educational, technical or vocational training institutes at primary, secondary, post-secondary, university or post-graduate level;</li> <li>in need of financial assistance for educational purposes.</li> <li>estimated expenses of the applicant for the academic year are not covered by other bursaries or funds (according to the status as at the deadline of application).</li> </ol>
