To excel in professional education and to promote whole person development, the City University of Hong Kong has established “A+++ Scholarship Scheme” for local students with outstanding academic and/or non-academic achievement to be admitted to CityU’s full-time bachelor degree programme through Joint University Programmes Admissions System (JUPAS). JUPAS applicants will be granted the scholarship(s) if they meet the relevant requirements.

Outstanding Achievement Awards	New students admitted to the University’s bachelor’s degree programme through Self Recommendation Scheme of the Joint University Programmes Admissions System (JUPAS) will be eligible for consideration of a one-off tuition scholarship in their first year of study if they have demonstrated outstanding performance in academic / non-academic international level competition. Note 2 Renewal of Entrance scholarship will be granted on an annual basis, subject to continued satisfactory academic performance of the recipient (i.e. CGPA at 3.0 or above by the end of Semester B each year). Each scholarship is tenable for a maximum of three or four years depending on the duration of the registered bachelor degree programme of the recipient.

Note 3 Students who have obtained renewal of entrance scholarship will also be awarded a student exchange scholarship for an exchange programme at an overseas or Mainland university in their second or third year of study.

Note 4 Renewal of Residence Scholarship / Sports Entrance Scholarship will be granted on an annual basis, subject to (a) continued satisfactory academic performance of the recipient (i.e. CGPA at 2.5 or above by the end of Semester B each year); and (b) continued satisfactory sports performance as determined by the Physical Education Section of Student Development Services.

Support Services for Entrance Scholarship recipients:

- Exchange Scholarship: An Exchange Scholarship will be provided to each recipient in his/her second or third year of study to have an exchange study programme in an overseas or Mainland university for one semester. This exchange programme inspires students with new experience and helps them establish a globalized vision.
- Training Activities: The University provides a series of training activities, including workshops and talks, to nurture and to develop the talents of these future leaders.
