

**HKSAR Government Scholarship Fund – Non-Academic Awards 2022/23**  
**Information Notes**

<b>Value of the Award</b>	:	HK\$10,000 each, for both local and non-local students
<b>Target group</b>	:	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Students currently studying full-time UGC-funded degree or above level and sub-degree programmes</li> <li>• The majority of recipients should be <u>local</u> students.</li> <li>• Students pursuing Joint Bachelor's Degree programme and exchange students who are <i>not</i> studying a full degree or above programme in Hong Kong are <b>NOT</b> eligible for the Awards.</li> <li>• Students who are taking leave of absence in a particular semester in the current academic year, i.e. 2022/23, are <b>NOT</b> eligible for the Awards.</li> </ul>

**1. Talent Development Scholarship (TDS)**

**a. Aims and scope of areas**

- (i) The TDS aims to give recognition to students who have **demonstrated achievements or talents in non-academic areas** and provide support for these students to further develop their talent and potential.
- (ii) The TDS will be offered to students who have demonstrated talent or potential in at least one of the following areas:
  - a) Sports and games;
  - b) Music and performing arts;
  - c) Culture, arts and design; or
  - d) Innovation, science and technology

**b. Criteria**

- (i) Demonstration of achievements in any of the above areas within **recent three years (i.e. 1 January 2019 to present)**; in addition, awardees should at least:
  - Receive an award in **national or regional** competitions/performances; or represent institution or relevant association in such competitions/performances **and** have good recommendation/assessment by the institution or relevant organization on the capability or talent; **or**
  - Receive an award (except commendable award in recognition of participation) in **local/ inter-school/ inter-institution** competitions.

Remarks:

- Students who only participate in the following activities should NOT normally be awarded TDS. These activities include:
  - a) Being a team member/ committee member of a school team/ club/ society
  - b) Intra-school/ intra-institution activities
  - c) Work-related activities (e.g. internship/ helpers or workers of an event etc.) or activities which form part of the academic requirements
  - d) All types of examinations (e.g. ABRSM Exams, SAT, ACCA Exams, etc.)
  - e) Language proficiency tests/trade tests (e.g. IELTS, TOFEL, etc.)
- (ii) Achieve good academic attainment **with CGPA 2.5 or above** by the end of Semester A in the 2022-23 academic year.
- (iii) A student may be awarded the TDS more than once throughout his/her studies of the relevant programme, and each application should be considered based on individual

merits. Students who have been awarded the TDS before must be able to provide new evidence of award(s) and achievement(s) attained after receiving the TDS award in previous academic years.

## 2. Reaching Out Award (ROA)

### a. Aims

- (i) The ROA aims to equip students with an international vision, broadening their exposure to multicultural environment and enhancing their communication skills in English, Putonghua or other languages.
- (ii) It enables students to **participate in an event/competition (e.g. conferences/forums/workshops/seminars/training camps/competitions, service projects, etc.), partake in an internship or a placement (credit-bearing/non-credit bearing), take part in a field/study trip or attend a course (e.g. foreign language immersion programmes, academic exchange programmes#, etc.)** that is conducted **outside Hong Kong in the 2022-23 academic year (i.e. 1 September 2022 to 31 August 2023)**.
- (iii) The outreaching activities should either be **organized or endorsed by College/ School/ Department**.

### b. Criteria

- (i) Achieve good academic attainment **with CGPA 3.0 or above** by the end of Semester A in the 2022-23 academic year.
- (ii) The ROA can only be provided to the same student **once** throughout the entire study programme.
- (iii) Each awardee is required to **submit a reflection report (at least 1,000 words in English or Chinese) within one month of completion of the outreaching activity** to the institutions on the activities participated and the learning experiences and benefits acquired.

#### Remarks:

*#Academic exchange programmes refer to those exchange programmes conducting on short-term basis, **not** including semester-based exchange programmes (institutional or departmental level).*
