Restructuring of Companies in Financial Distress: Global and Asian Perspectives

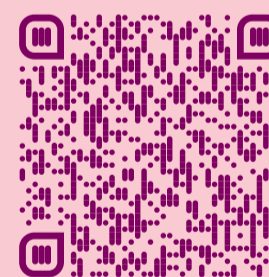

4. Assessing effectiveness of tools of restructuring: provisional liquidations, schemes of arrangement, work-outs
5. The impact of restructuring reforms in the last decade
6. Conflicts among stakeholders in restructurings, agency costs
7. Role of insolvency practitioners in restructurings
8. Role of the courts in restructurings
