CityU LLMArbDR and LLM Programmes Obtain Fellowships from UGC

The Master of Laws in Arbitration and Dispute Resolution (LLMArbDR) and the Master of Laws (LLM) in Corporate and Commercial Law of City University of Hong Kong have successfully obtained fellowships from the University Grants Committee's (UGC) Targeted Taught Postgraduate Programmes Fellowships Scheme (Second Cohort) for 2021/22 intake. The main purpose of the Scheme is to attract meritorious local students to pursue further studies in priority areas that are conducive to the development of Hong Kong.

Under the scheme, 13 fellowship places would be made available for the LLMArbDR and 3 fellowship places for the LLM in Corporate and Commercial Law. The fellowship recipients are required to pay a minimum tuition fee of HK\$42,100 and the differences will be subsidized by the fellowships subject to a cap of HK\$120,000 for each student regardless of the actual study period of their programme.

The admission for 2021/22 intake for the above two programmes will commence in mid-November 2020.
