Professor Gerard Mols, Rector Magnificus of Maastricht University in the Netherlands, Professor of criminal law and criminal procedure, visited School of Law, City University of Hong Kong (CityU) on 12 October 2010. He met with the Professor Wang Guiguo (Dean), Professor Anton Cooray, Associate Professor Gu Minkang (Associate Deans) and programme leaders of various law curriculums.

At the meeting, Professor Mols was briefed with the edges of CityU Law School, such as the Global Leadership and Awareness Project (G-LEAP); and several of our latest projects including the involvement in the G-15 of Law Schools pilot project launched by the United Nations Conference on Trade and Development; and the strengths of our law programmes. Programme leaders briefed Professor Mols of our curriculums, including Bachelor of Laws (LLB), Master of Laws (LLM), Postgraduate Diploma of Law (PCLL) and Master of Laws in Arbitration and Dispute Resolution (LLMArbDR).

Professor Mols shared with us the various law programmes in the Maastricht University. The two institutions explored academic exchange opportunities for the students. Despite different jurisdictional background with Hong Kong on common law while the Netherlands on civil law system, the parties explored on collaboration of offering joint degrees.
