

## Peking University Law School Visits CityU School of Law

Peking University Law School's delegation of nine faculty and administrative staff visited the School of Law at City University of Hong Kong. The representatives included **Professor Zhang Shouwen**, Dean of the Peking University Law School as well as **Professor Pan Jianfeng**, **Professor Wang Jiancheng**, and **Professor Wang Xixin**, all Associate Deans of the Peking University Law School.

**Associate Dean Gu Minkang** of CityU Law School along with Associate Professor **Dr He Xin**, and Assistant Professors **Dr Chen Lei**, **Dr Guan Wenwei**, and **Dr Wan Ke**, received the delegation.

Associate Dean Gu provided an overview of the various law degree programmes offered by City University of Hong Kong School of Law at both the undergraduate and postgraduate levels. The representatives of Peking University's Law School were interested in learning about the dual Master of Laws degree programme offered by our Law School and other Mainland institutions. Professor Wang Jiancheng, Associate Dean of Peking University Law School, stated that their law school also offered a Master of Laws programme in English and proposed that a similar agreement would allow both law schools to be truly globalized with students from different jurisdictions.

The group engaged in further discussions on an arrangement whereby faculty of Peking University could assist with CityU School of Law's Doctor of Juridical Science (JSD) programme for senior Chinese judges. The delegation also tested and discussed the possibility of using the School of Law's video-link facility and toured the law section of CityU's Run Run Shaw Library. The visit ended with an enjoyable dinner, which included further discussions on teaching and research interests.
