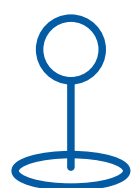

ABSTRACT

In this talk, Prof. Peter Jezzard will share practical insights into full lifecycle of preparing a scientific manuscript – from structuring a clear and compelling paper to navigating the submission and peer-review process. Drawing on his extensive editorial and publishing experience, he will highlight common pitfalls that authors encounter, effective strategies for addressing reviewer comments, and approaches to strengthening a manuscript through revisions.

BIOGRAPHY

Prof. Peter Jezzard is a leading figure in MRI research and Professor of Neuroimaging at the University of Oxford. His work focuses on mapping the brain's macro- and micro-vascular architecture, developing rapid imaging approaches to support the diagnosis and treatment of acute stroke and small vessel disease, and advancing ultra-high-field MRI using 7T scanner. This includes integrating cutting-edge hardware, such as parallel RF transmission, with modern acquisition strategies. In the MRI community, he served the Magnetic Resonance in Medicine (ISMRM) in multiple capacities, including as President (2013–2014). Since 2020, he has been the Editor-in-Chief of Society journal Magnetic Resonance in Medicine.
