CityU CAREer Launch Scheme 2021 (CARLS 2.0)



CAREer Launch Scheme (CARLS) 2.0 has been launched in April this year to facilitate our Class of 2021 graduates to land their first full-time jobs. By its conclusion in November 2021, CARLS 2.0 had reached out to more than 18,000 partnering organisations and employers, creating more than 4,100 job vacancies for the graduates, in which more than 800 of them have already secured job offers.

To mark the successful completion of CARLS 2.0, I would like to share with you its key achievements as follows:

- **4,100+ job vacancies** were created for 2021 CityU graduates
- **800+ 2021 CityU graduates** secured offers under this scheme
- **2,880+ students searched CARLS jobs on JobPlus**, with a total of 21,280+ page access
- **2,800+** CityU graduates received **one-on-one career and job search consultations**
- **60+ press and media coverages** on CARLS were recorded between July and October 2021
