

The CityU CAReer Launch Scheme (CARLS) which is designed to maximise the employability and competitiveness of CityU graduates has been successfully launched in the last two years. We would like to continue the good practice to provide continued support to all Class of 2022 graduates through our CARLS 3.0. As of today, **over 2,400** employers have been contacted, and **over 610** full-time job vacancies have been received. The job information is now accessible on the online platform JobPlus via <u>AIMS</u>.

Key features of CARLS 3.0 include:

- **Professional support on job search and career consultation** from our dedicated team of College-based Careers and Employability Consultants;
- Special **in-house online job postings** and alerts to facilitate job search;
- An **online platform JobPlus** for Class of 2022 graduates to view the job information under CARLS 3.0 through AIMS;
- An **online Job Expo platform** to share participated employers' information and job openings;
- **An enhanced matching fund** for employers, who provide work opportunities for CityU graduates, at 1/3 of his/her monthly salary, capped at HK\$7,000 per CityU graduate per month, for up to 3 months;
- A comprehensive advocacy campaign to outreach potential and current employers to support the job landing of CityU graduates.

In addition, a team of 4 Careers and Employability Consultants (CECs) has been recruited to provide one-on-one career coaching, CV polishing, job matching and employer networking support under CARLS 3.0. The contact information of 4 College/School based CECs is as follows:
