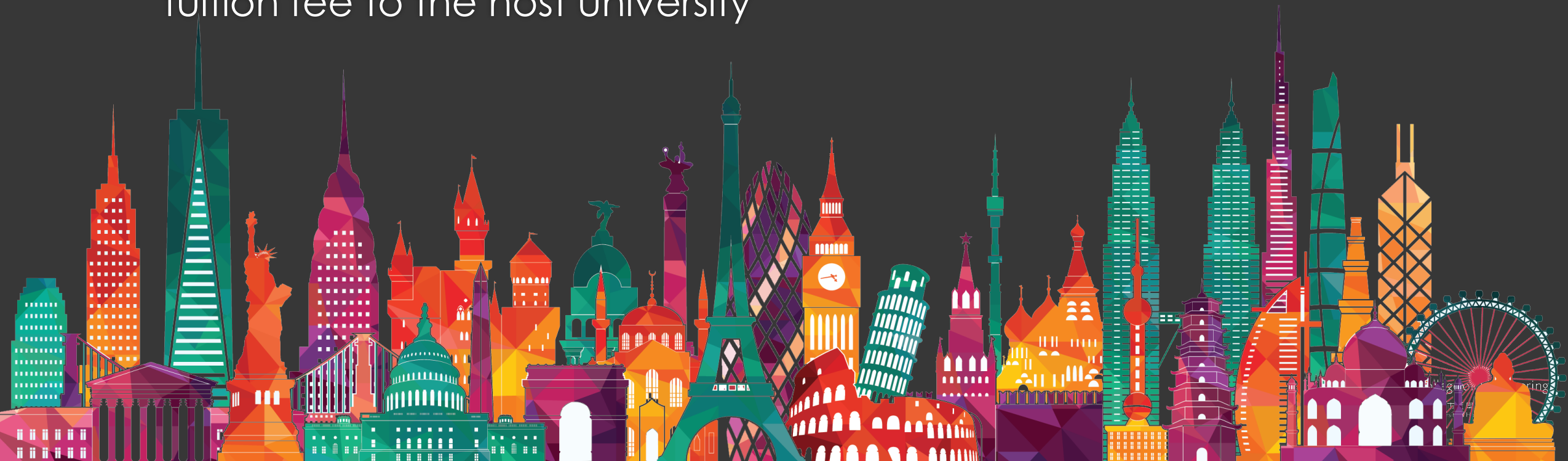

What is Student Exchange Programme?

- An opportunity for students to study for a semester or at least 4 weeks during the summer at a partner university
- Credits earned can be transferred back to CityU without paying tuition fee to the host university



Eligibility

- Full-time student in a government-funded bachelor's degree programme offered by CityU
- Completed at least 1 year of study with a major declared before applying
- CGPA of 2.5 in the latest semester of study
- Fulfill the minimum English language requirements
 - TOEFL (iBT) 79 (valid for **2 years** from the test taken date)
 - IELTS 6.5 (valid for **2 years** from the test taken date)
 - Grade C in an approved University English courses (e.g. GE1401, GE2410)
 - HKDSE Level 4
 - except for programmes that are conducted in Chinese at partner institutions in Mainland China or Taiwan;
- Meet the language requirements, if any, set by the host institution

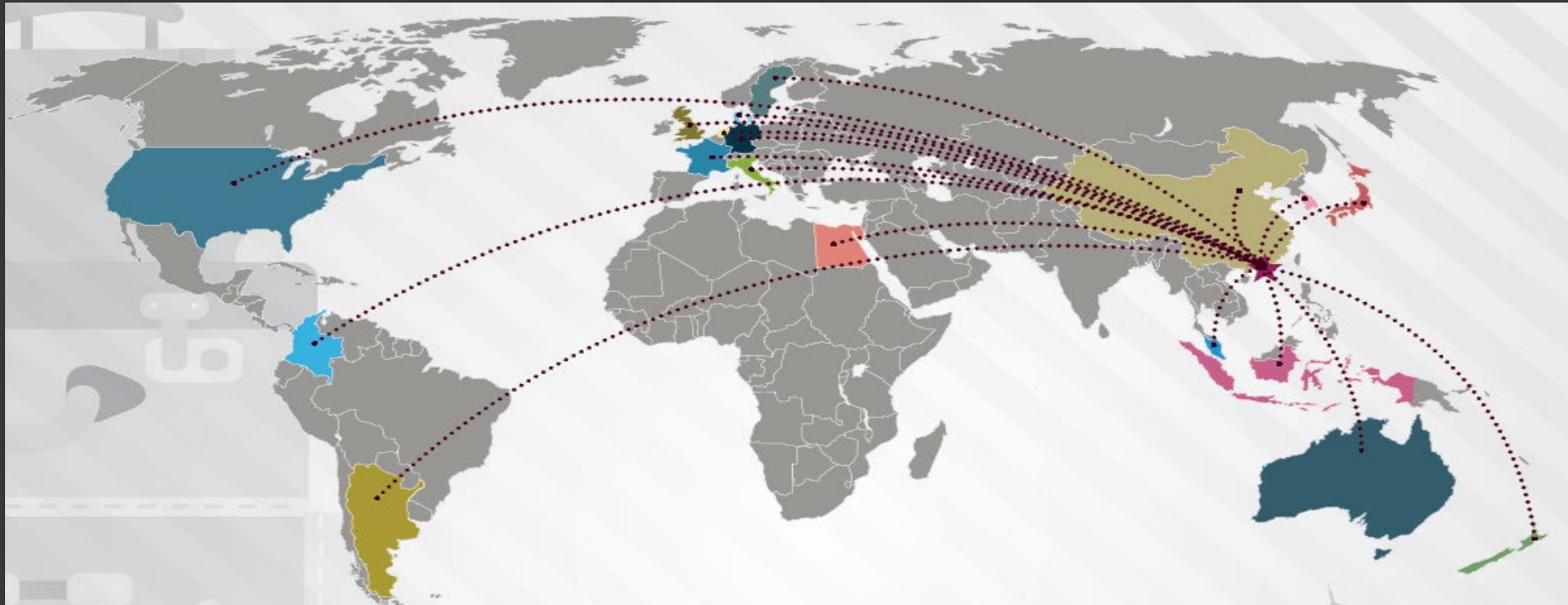

Complete Student Exchange Programme application form in AIMS (under "Student Services") during the application periods:

Main round: 11 Dec 2023 to 22 Jan 2024

Clearing round: Aug to Sep 2024

Selection Criteria

- The weighting of the two assessment areas are as follows:

Areas for Assessment	Weighting (%)
CGPA	50
English Language Proficiency* (inapplicable to candidates contending for programmes taught and assessed in Chinese in Mainland China and Taiwan)	50
Application Statement **	N/A
Total:	100

* Students who are able to produce a valid IELTS (min. overall band 6.5) or TOEFL (min. iBT test score 79) will have an advantage in the selection process.

** The Application Statement submitted as part of the application may be used for assessment, when necessary.

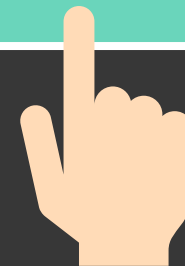

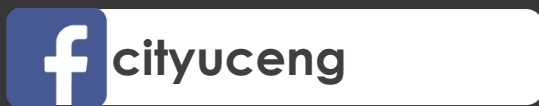
