Programme Features

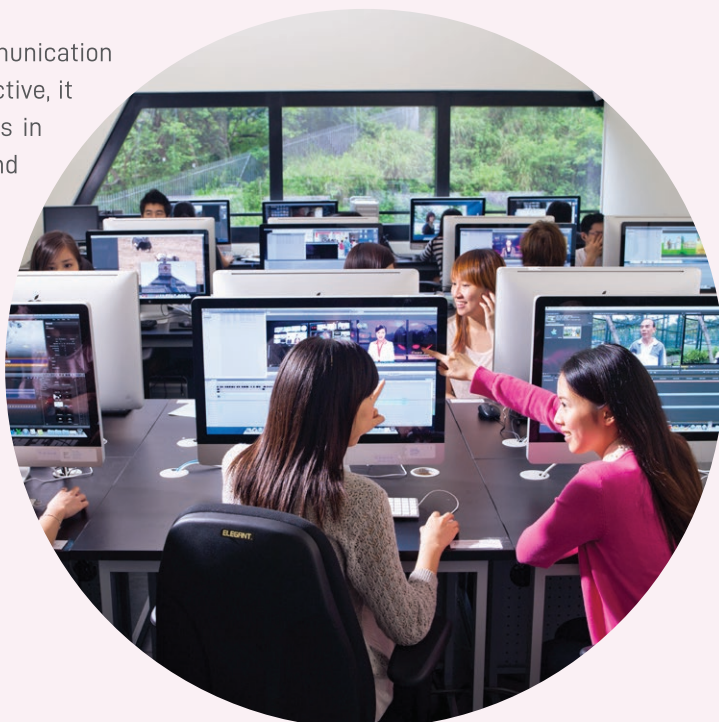

2-year programme (Advanced Standing II)

Applicants are normally expected to have completed an Associate Degree / Higher Diploma with a Cumulative Grade Point Average (CGPA) of at least 3.0 or an equivalent overall mark, or a credit award, AND to have attained at least Level 3 or above in HKDSE English Language and Chinese Language or an equivalent qualification.

3-year programme (Advanced Standing I)

Associate Degree / Higher Diploma graduates who do not receive a senior-year (Advanced Standing II) place, or graduating students or graduates of high school following non-HKDSE curriculum (e.g. IB, GCE) / transfer students from local or overseas bachelor's degree programmes from other universities, may be considered for Advanced Standing I admission.
