FAQ for Internship Courses

1. How do I know if the internship is considered programme-related or not?

You can consult and seek advice from your department's internship coordinator before or after you start the internship. Contact details are as follows:

2. What is the difference between the four courses?

The last digit of the course code (CSCI0001/2/3/4) denotes the year of study. CSCI0001 will be registered for Year 1 students; CSCI0002 will be registered for Year 2 students and so on. Enrolment for the course is allowed year-round, except for CSCI0004, which is only available in Semester A or Semester B.

3. Can I enroll for the course more than once throughout the academic year?

Each student is only allowed to register the course once in that particular year of study.

4. Is there any restriction on the location of the internship?

No. The location can be in Hong Kong or overseas.

6. How are the internship courses different from the internship schemes (eg. IAS, OIS, CES) offered by the College of Science?

The internship courses offered by the College of Science carries at least 3 credits and is designed for students who are in Year 3. All job specifications and requirements have been pre-approved by the College and the internship duration will be at least 9 weeks long.

For the internship course (0 credit), the internship is self-solicited by student and the internship duration is minimum 2 weeks (full-time) or 75 work hours (part-time).

7. Can I enroll in this internship course and IAS/OIS/CES at the same time?

If your internship is already enrolled under IAS/OIS/CES, you cannot enroll in the internship course (0 credit) using the same internship. It is acceptable if they are two different internships.

8. I am participating in the STEM Internship Scheme. Can I use this internship to enroll in the 0 credit internship course?

Yes, as long as your internship fulfils the requirements of the course. However, job assignments under STEM Internship Scheme are not eligible for CLC's Incentive Programme.

9. Will the internship course appear on my transcript?

If you have fulfilled all the requirements and passed the course, the course will be recorded on your academic transcript.
