- B. Solicit *Recommendation Letter(s)* from your sports club/coach to prove your current sports performance (within 2 years).
- C. Submit your *Academic Transcripts* including TOEFL and/or IELTS Certificates.
- D. Submit a Curriculum Vitae/Personal Resume stating your sports achievements.
 - Include Web Link(s) (on YouTube or any cloud storage sharing website) of your competition video(s) demonstrating your sports performance during official match(es) in full length/a 15-20 minutes of your playtime/a few sets played; with the indication of your jersey colour & number for identification.
- E. Solicit a Letter from a Physician to prove your physical & medical condition to be fit to participate in sports competitions at your current level of play. The letter should be issued within 3 months of application.
- F. Send the completed nomination form together with the above supporting documents to the Global Engagement Office at geo@cityu.edu.hk and the Physical Education Section at sope@cityu.edu.hk.
