### Dear JCC Community,

Last Friday we achieved a significant milestone – submission of over 1000 files of information to an online repository for the accreditation of the BVM Program by the Royal College of Veterinary Surgeons (RCVS). This was a huge task and has involved many months of preparation with input not only from many in the JCC community but also from multiple University offices (Campus Development Office, Facilities Management Office, Student Development Services to name a few), our internal partners and many external stakeholders. The RCVS will review this information and design a bespoke site visit in June based on our submission. I have no doubt that the careful preparatory work will stand us in good stead for the subsequent visitation by the RCVS accreditation team.

The next deadline will be submission of the self-evaluation report for the Australasian Veterinary Boards Council (AVBC) on April 3<sup>rd</sup>. But for now, we can exhale, acknowledge what we have accomplished together and have a breather. I am very grateful to all who have contributed and continue to contribute to our accreditation preparations.

In other news, CityU was honoured to host a visit on the 10<sup>th</sup> February from the Provost of Cornell University Prof. Michael Kotlikoff and to celebrate the strength of collaborations between our partner institutions, not only with the BVM Programme but also with the successful interdisciplinary Cornell/CityU PhD program.

In this Newsletter you will find a new section on Research Grants. I have asked our Associate Dean of Research Prof. Han Cheng to keep faculty in all departments abreast of grants that are open for applications and of their upcoming deadlines. I encourage broader interdisciplinary research between departments, which have complementary strengths. Prof. Cheng will also have a leading role in the upcoming Research Assessment Exercise (RAE) for JCC. Please stay tuned for further details.

One of the strengths of the JCC is both its commitment to research and our high research output. Our PhD students make a huge contribution to the research output of the College. Good PhD supervision is key to success, both for the graduate student and the research outcomes of the JCC. If you are a first-time PhD supervisor, please ensure that you have a PhD mentor and a co-supervisor for your students. It's also prudent to exercise caution in the number of PhD students that you supervise. Recently some issues with PhD supervision in the College have been brought to my attention. To that end, I have asked the Graduate Studies Review Committee to review PhD supervision in the JCC. The aim is to ensure that QA mechanisms are in place and that both PhD students and faculty supervising them have an optimal experience.
