


Professor Xiaoming LI, Vice President of Zhejiang University presented a seminar entitled "Fear, Anxiety and Depression" on 11 August 2023.



Orientation of MSc Public Health & Epidemiology: A Warm Welcome and Introduction to the Program

The orientation for the Master of Science (MSc) in Public Health & Epidemiology was held on the CityU Campus on August 29th and 30th, 2023. **Professor Huiyong YIN**, the Associate Dean (Research), and Department Head Professor Olivier SPARAGANO were present at the event, both offering a warm welcome to the incoming students.

The event also featured **Professor Patrick BUTAYE**, the faculty representative, who shared his insights and experiences with the students. His inspirational words were aimed at motivating the students and providing them with a glimpse of the enriching journey they have embarked on.



The program's leader, **Professor Ming Wai Kit**, then introduced the MSc Public Health & Epidemiology Program & Curriculum. Professor Ming highlighted the in-depth nature of the course, designed to prepare the students for a successful career in public health.



Following the introduction, **Mr. Richard SHAH** led a two-day Induction Program, which provided the students with essential information about the course, the faculty, and the university. The induction program also included interactive sessions and workshops aimed at facilitating a smooth transition for the students into their new academic environment. The activities were centred around leadership & self-development, which included team building activities, and self-assessments using the Myers Briggs Type Indicator framework.
