



香港城市大学-美国哥伦比亚大学 双联学士学位课程

香港城市大学-美国哥伦比亚大学双联学士学位课程为学生提供国际化本科学习经验。该项目在传统的本科教育中融入创新要素，在保持两所世界知名大学既有的学术严谨性的同时，也对学生知识结构形成过程中社会和文化传统所起的作用极为关注。学生在完成香港城市大学和美国哥伦比亚大学两所学校同一专业的本科课程后，毕业时将分别获得两所大学所颁发的学士学位。

学制及专业设置

有意申请香港城市大学-美国哥伦比亚大学双联学士学位课程的学生，在第一阶段(即第一和第二学年)必须进入和美国哥伦比亚大学课程对接的十二个香港城市大学本科专业之一学习；申请成功后在第二阶段(即第三和第四学年)去到美国哥伦比亚大学继续完成核心课程及专业必修课程。

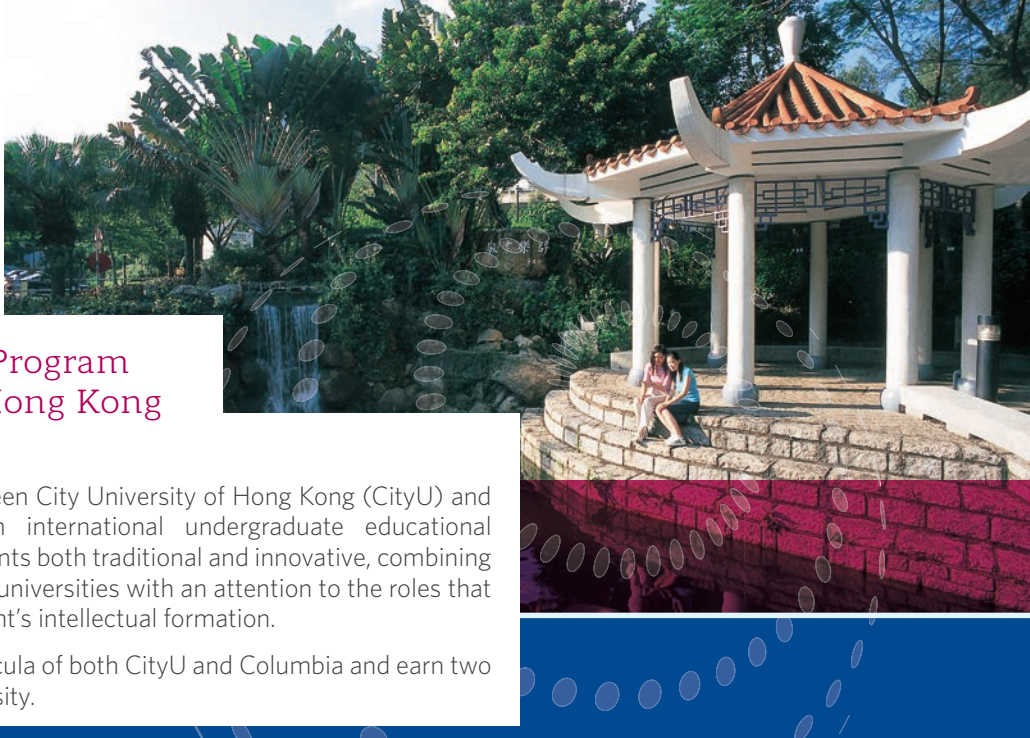

The Joint Bachelor's Degree Program between City University of Hong Kong and Columbia University

The Joint Bachelor's Degree Program between City University of Hong Kong (CityU) and Columbia University offers students an international undergraduate educational experience. The program draws upon elements both traditional and innovative, combining the academic rigor of two world-renowned universities with an attention to the roles that social and cultural traditions play in a student's intellectual formation.

Students complete the undergraduate curricula of both CityU and Columbia and earn two bachelor's degrees — one from each university.



Academics

During the first phase of the program, years one and two, students at CityU follow one of the majors noted below before applying for admission to the Joint Bachelor's Degree Program. Admitted students spend years three and four at Columbia, finishing core and major requirements for both degrees.

² Students in this major are required to take additional courses and should expect to take longer than two years to complete their study at Columbia University.

³ The combination track requires a selection of six advanced courses (18 points). Students will combine computer science with another discipline in the arts, humanities, social or natural sciences by studying three courses in computer science and another three from another discipline.

⁴ Students are required to complete a mandatory one-year internship in Hong Kong prior to the commencement of study at Columbia University.

⁵ Only applicable to students of the Applied Sociology Stream.

⁶ Only applicable to students of the Public Affairs and Governance Stream.

Financial Aid

CITYU

Students with excellent academic performance are eligible for scholarships at CityU based on academic merit or financial need. CityU students accepted to the Joint Bachelor's Degree Program may also apply for scholarships/awards that are designated for studies at Columbia.

COLUMBIA

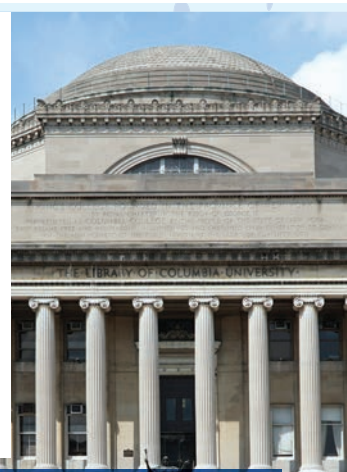
Students in the program will be eligible to apply for need-based financial aid at Columbia University consistent with other students enrolled at the School of General Studies.

An invitation to apply for admission to the Joint Bachelor's Degree Program will be sent to eligible students in the fall semester of their second year at CityU.
