## Online Education and Flipped Classroom: Exploring Hybrid Learning in the Post-Covid Era

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This webinar will present our survey results about Hong Kong university students' learning experiences and perceptions of distance education. The COVID-enforced remote teaching has coerced both teachers and students to adapt to online classes. While there have been various difficulties as perceived by students, many also found benefits and new learning experiences brought by online classes. We will delineate the major advantages and disadvantages of remote learning as well as the different experiences between science and non-science students. We argue that despite the fact that COVID control has come to an end, and school life has returned to normal, the experiences in online classes are worth for further exploration and for the enhancement of university education. As a majority of the respondents have opted for a hybrid mode of teaching, taking advantage of IT enabled distance learning space and flipped classroom will help advance university education in the near future.



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
