Jackie Chan Charitable Foundation Exchange Scholarships

Purpose

To provide scholarships to enable qualified outbound exchange students to join exchange study without financial worry.

Eligibility

All outbound exchange students who are **full-time UGC-funded undergraduate students from School of Creative Media** and have met the following criteria:

- 1. have achieved a CGPA of 3 or above;
- 2. have proven financial difficulties;
- 3. have been given exchange offer in the main round application of the Student Exchange Programme, in order to receive the scholarship before departure.
- 4. have fulfilled, before departing for exchange studies, the English language requirements□ for exchange programme using English as the medium of instruction, or other language proficiency or special requirement as specified for individual programme; and
- 5. have not participated in similar University-subsidized overseas exchange programmes.

Scholarship Value and Number of Awards

There shall be **4 awards** each year. The value of each scholarship is **HK\$30,000**.

Timeline

Students who go for exchange in Semester A shall receive the amount of scholarship in August while those who go for exchange in Semester B shall receive the amount in December.

Condition

- The scholarship recipients are allowed to receive sponsorship from Student Exchange
 Fund concurrently for the outbound exchange programme. However, the University
 reserves the right to demand for a partial or full refund of the scholarship should any
 scholarship recipient fail to complete the exchange programme or he/she fails to achieve a
 minimum pass grade in each of his/her subject(s).
- 2. Scholarship recipients are required to submit a report (in English) on their exchange study (not less than 800 words) within one month upon students' return to Hong Kong.

- 3. Scholarship recipients are required to report their employment status to the School of Creative Media for 3 years upon graduation.
- 4. Scholarship recipients are obliged to attend the scholarship presentation ceremony as organized by the donor or by the University.

Application Procedure and Deadline

Eligible students should submit their completed <u>application form</u> and relevant supporting document by **30 April** to the General Office of School of Creative Media. **Late submission will not be considered.**

All scholarship applications received will be passed to the Associate Dean for making a final decision.
