#### Introduction

If you are a full-time student pursuing above mentioned accredited self-financing degree programme, aged 30 or below and have the right of abode in Hong Kong or have resided / had a home in Hong Kong continuously for three complete years immediately prior to the commencement of your programme, you are eligible to apply for financial assistance through this Scheme which is administered by the Hong Kong Government. ## Maximum Grant & Loan Offered to CityU Students

### **A. Maximum Grant 2016/17**

The maximum level of financial assistance is capped at the annual tuition fee payable for the accredited programme and an academic expenses grant subject to a ceiling which will be reviewed annually. The ceiling for 2016/17 academic year for tuition fee is HK\$78,610. The ceiling for academic expenses grant is HK\$5,430. ## Student Travel Subsidy Scheme (STS)

### **Eligibility**

- Study in self-financing full time accredited degree programme
- Succeed in FASP application
- Reside (at home / hostel) beyond 10 minute's walking distance from place of study
- Require the use of public transport

Students wish to apply for student travel subsidy, they must enter "✓" in box 237 under Part E of FASP Application form. The applicants who have been approved to receive any kind of travel allowance are NOT entitled to apply for STS from the SFO.
