Chao King Lin Community Service Scholarships Regulations

Mr Chao King Lin has agreed to donate a number of annual scholarships to the City University of Hong Kong with effect from the 2017/18 academic year for ten consecutive academic years. The following regulations shall apply as of 2023/24:

- 1. The Scholarships shall be known as the "Chao King Lin Community Service Scholarships".
- 2. There shall be a maximum of TWO scholarships per annum. The value of each scholarship shall be HK\$15,000.
- 3. The Scholarships shall be offered to full-time UGC-funded degree or associate degree students who have:
 - a. achieved demonstrable record in the provision of service to fellow students, the University or the community; and
 - b. obtained good academic results with a CGPA of 3.0 or above in the previous year.
- 4. Student Development Services shall invite applications in October/November each year and shall inform the donor of the list of scholarship recipients via the Development Office as soon as the selection exercise is completed.

Remark:

With an objective to nurture our students and to promote caring culture, the University encourages each award recipient to make an annual donation of HK\$200 or more to the City University of Hong Kong for student support via CityU Alumni Giving Club when they are in employment after graduation. This term has been incorporated into all scholarship/prize/award/bursary schemes since February 2008.
