### Introduction

The Non-means-tested Loan Scheme for Post-secondary Students (NLSPS) is established by the government to complement the Financial Assistance Scheme for Post-Secondary Students (FASP) to meet students' tuition fees, academic expenses and basic living expenses. The Scheme is operated on a no-gain-no-loss and cost recovery basis. Interest rate is subject to periodic adjustment. Students eligible for assistance under FASP are eligible for NLSPS. #### Online Application Form (E-submission)

All NLSPS applicants are required to submit their applications through the online application form at SFO E-link – My Applications platform (<https://ess.wfsfaa.gov.hk>). **No more hard copy of application form can be submitted / processed.**

Applicants are only required to submit to the SFO the transaction advice or ATM transaction advice for the **administrative fee** paid (**HK\$180**) together with the loan documents upon acceptance of the loan.

### Application Period

**For Full-time Current Students: (Application deadline: 26 June 2020)**

In 2020/21 academic year, NLSPS applicants should submit their applications through the online application form at SFO E-link – My Applications platform (<https://ess.wfsfaa.gov.hk>) from 2 May 2020 to 26 June 2020.

Please note that the earlier you hand in your application, the earlier your application will be processed. And you may obtain your Non-means-tested Loan in time to cover your tuition fee for 2020/21.

### Documents Required

- i) Completed NLSPS application form
- ii) Copy of your Hong Kong ID card
- iii) Copy of your student ID card
- iv) Copy of your bank book's first page or statement showing your name and account number
- v) Copy of document showing your name and your pursuing programme
- vi) Copy of automatic teller machines (ATM) transaction advice for the administrative fee payment <sup>△</sup>

<sup>△</sup> The original copy of automatic teller machines (ATM) transaction advice for the administrative fee payment **should be submitted together with the loan documents and the required documents to the SFO upon acceptance of the NLSPS loans.**

### NOTE

Full-time students of self-financing programme who wish to apply for both FASP and NLSPS have to submit the FASP and NLSPS application forms separately.
