Procedures for Handling Mitigation Request

- (1) The procedures for handling mitigation request by SEE students for missing mid-term test and final examination are approved for implementation with effect from Semester A 2019/2020.
- (2) Details of the procedures are as follows:

For requests by undergraduate students:

- a. The Associate Dean (Undergraduate Studies) and/or Major Leaders will review all mitigation requests. If the reason for mitigation is deemed legitimate (i.e., no ill intent to deliberately miss the assessment to gain an advantage), a make-up mid-term test or final examination will be arranged by the Course Leader.
- b. For students requesting mitigation more than once in the same semester, an interview by Associate Dean (Undergraduate Studies) and/or Major Leaders must be conducted. If the reason for mitigation is deemed legitimate (i.e., no ill intent to deliberately miss the assessment to gain an advantage), the makeup assessment for mid-term test or final examination will take the form of an intensive oral examination with the duration set by the Course Leader.

For requests by **postgraduate** students:

- c. The Associate Dean (Research and Graduate Studies) and/or MSc Programme Leader/PhD Coordinator will review all mitigation requests. If the reason for mitigation is deemed legitimate (i.e., no ill intent to deliberately miss the assessment to gain an advantage), a make-up mid-term test or final examination will be arranged by the Course Leader.
- d. For students requesting mitigation more than once in the same semester, an interview by Associate Dean (Research and Graduate Studies) and/or MSc Programme Leader/PhD Coordinator must be conducted. If the reason for mitigation is deemed legitimate (i.e., no ill intent to deliberately miss the assessment to gain an advantage), the make-up assessment for mid-term test or final examination will take the form of an intensive oral examination with the duration set by the Course Leader.

(3) Arrangement of make-up oral examination

a. Questions of oral examination will be moderated by another faculty member. Level of difficulty of the oral examination cannot be deviated much from the one of the original examination.

- b. One more faculty member other than the Course Leader will attend the oral examination.
- c. Audio recording will be arranged during the oral examination.
- (4) Given that these procedures are announced to students on School website and via email, complaints lodged by students concerning the procedures after release of course grade will not be entertained.
