Guidelines on Taking Guided Study and Special Project

(A) **Overview**

- 1. These Guidelines are applicable to the following courses.
 - (a) *SEE4994 Guided Study in Energy and Environment* (3 credit units)
 - (b) SEE4995 Guided Study in Energy and Environment (6 credit units)
 - (c) *SEE4998 Special Project in Energy and Environment* (3 credit units)
 - (d) SEE4999 Special Project in Energy and Environment (6 credit units)

2. Supervisor

- (a) Supervisor of the Guided Study / Special Project must be chosen among the SEE faculty members (<u>https://www.cityu.edu.hk/see/people#Faculty</u>).
- (b) Students are required to:
- identify the supervisor themselves and get the faculty member's consent of being the supervisor via email (two weeks in advance of the start of the semester preferably);
- work out the details of the Guided Study / Special Project such as the topic/title, scope, outcomes, etc., with the supervisor; and
- report the following issues to both the course coordinator and SEE General Office via an online form at <u>https://forms.office.com/r/dE5QMYwzHL</u> by the end of Teaching Week 1 of the corresponding semester / term.
 - Name of the supervisor
 - Title of the Guided Study / Special Project
- 3. Students are expected to spend approximately 9 hours per week (for a 13-week regular semester) <u>OR</u> 18 hours per week (for a 7-week summer term) on each Guided Study / Special Project.

(B) SEE4994 / SEE4995 Guided Study in Energy and Environment

- 1. By taking SEE4994, students will conduct <u>ONE semester-long guided study</u>.
- 2. By taking SEE4995, students can select either **Plan A** or **Plan B**.
 - (a) **Plan A** : conducting <u>ONE year-long guided study</u>
 - (b) **Plan B**: conducting <u>TWO different semester-long guided studies</u>, namely <u>Guided Study I and Guided Study II</u>
