About SEE2000

Definition of “Absent”

- Students who join the workshop **15 minutes or more later than the scheduled time** will be considered “Absent”.
- Similarly, those who **leave the workshop before the scheduled time** will also be regarded as “Absent”.
- Students are required to **show their CityU Student ID Card** to the Teaching Assistant upon arrival and departure for attendance taking purpose.
- **Warning letter** will be issued by the School Office to those who are absent. Students concerned will be suspended from taking SEE4000 Professional Development II until making-up the absence by participating in an identical workshop arranged by the SDS.

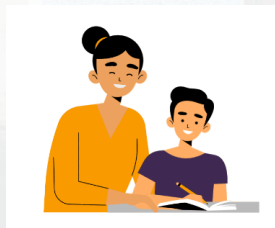

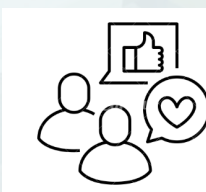

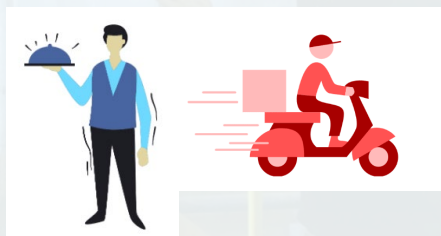

Examples of Experience that are acceptable

This list won't be exhaustive!



- **Reference letter** from company with letterhead and company stamp, stating your name and period of employment.
- **Attendance proof** from company with letterhead and company stamp, stating your name and period of employment.
- **Certificate of Appreciation**



- A **photo** showing you (and colleagues) standing in front of company logo.
- **Emails** from the company HR/your supervisor about offering a position to you.
- A word document stating that you are intern of a company, but there is **no official stamp/signature/letterhead** of the company on the letter.
