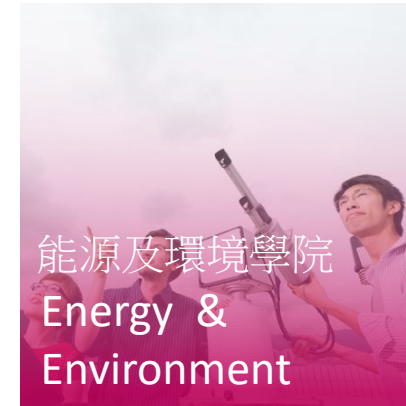
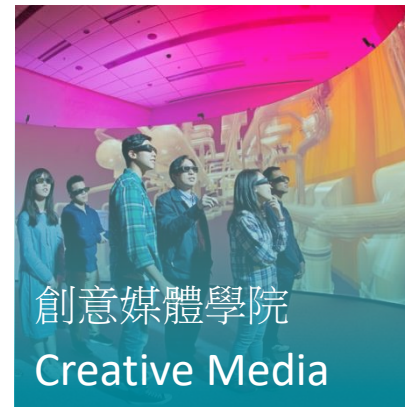

Important Information for Non-local Students

All non-local students must obtain valid visa/entry permit to study in Hong Kong.

Study Load

- All full-time student visa holders must observe the **minimum study load for full-time students (12 credit units in Semester A & Semester B)**.
- If full-time non-local students are unable to maintain the required study load, their cases may be reported to the HKSAR Immigration Department.

Visa Extension

- It is students' responsibility to ensure their student visas/entry permits are **valid until their expected graduation date**.
- Auto-email reminders will be sent to students **45, 21 and 7 days** before their visa expiry date in University systems.

- Please take action **at least 6-8 weeks before visa expiry** to:
 - (1) apply for a **certification letter** for extension of student visa from SGS; and immd.gov.hk/eng/services/visas/study.html


All non-local students must obtain valid visa/entry permit to study in Hong Kong.

Report New Visa Information

- Once a visa/entry permit is extended, students must report the new visa information via AIMS.
- Students who fail to report new visa information will be assumed ineligible for studies in Hong Kong and **will be barred from** accessing the Library, Computer Service Centre, CityUHK Portal and AIMS immediately upon visa expiry.
- The University reserves the right to terminate the studies of students who failed to obtain a renewed visa/entry and will report all such cases to the Immigration Department.

- Since the University is required to maintain your **Hong Kong Identity Card (HKID Card)** information in the student records system, after you have registered for a HKID Card, please submit your HKID Card information via AIMS
- To ensure your contact information at CityUHK is up-to-date, please provide your **address and mobile phone number in Hong Kong** via AIMS

The Psychological Testing Service at SDS offers CityU students a wide range of assessments on personal attributes, aptitudes, personality, and career-related issues. It aims to enhance students' self-understanding, assist them to develop personal growth plan, and strengthen their decision making ability on their life issues.

What are the tests?

Psychological Testing for Self-Understanding

Career Interests

Test: Strong Interest Inventory (SII)
identify career interests and a useful assessment for career planning

Conflict Management

Test: Thomas-Kilmann Conflict Mode Instrument (TKI)
assess individual's behavior in conflict situations and expand conflict management skill sets

assess leadership behaviour and learn steps to improve effectiveness as a student leader

3rd HK Tech 300 National Start-up Competition

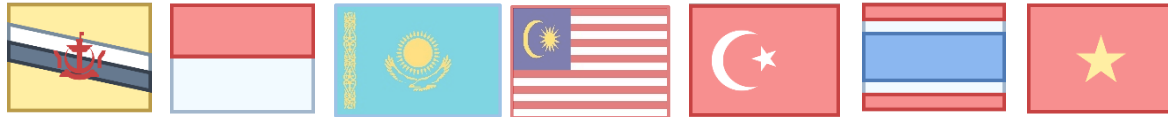
- Launched in 2022, the 1st Competition received **more than 280 applications, 14 start-ups** from Hong Kong and the Mainland were awarded. It covered 7 cities: Beijing, Chengdu, Changsha, Qingdao, Shanghai, Suzhou, Shenzhen.
- The 2nd Competition was **expanded to 9 cities** on the Mainland (Chongqing and Wuxi). **12 start-ups** from Hong Kong and the Mainland advanced to the Grand Final. The Grand Final and Award Ceremony was held on 1 September 2024, with the Top 3 and Special Awards selected.
- The 3rd Competition, **expanded to 12 mainland cities** (Dongguan, Hangzhou and Xi'an), was also launched at the same event.

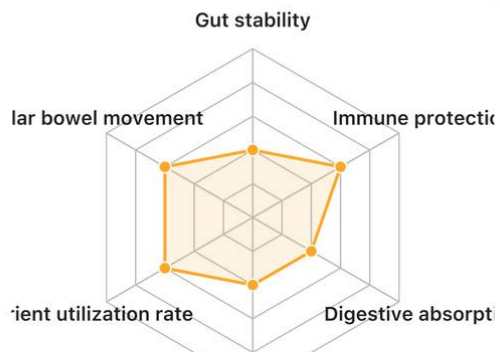
