General Information for Research Degree Students (2022/23)

The University offers on-campus accommodation for full-time research degree students and non-local taught postgraduate students in <u>UGC-funded programmes</u>. Application will be administered on a yearly basis. Due to the very limited residence places and increasing demand, the University is unable to offer residence places to UGC-funded research degree students for their entire study period. Furthermore, there is no guarantee at all that students will be granted residence places during their studies.

General Information for Research Degree Students

Students who are not successful in hall application are advised to visit "off-campus accommodation" for more

Application information (i.e. key dates) is announced on an SRO website around Mar/Apr every year

Hall places are allocated to eligible RPGs by lot-drawing in an impartial manner

SRO General Information for RPGs

Hall fee collection

Hall lodging fees are collected on a monthly basis

Early Withdrawal (1)

At least <u>one-month's written</u> <u>prior notice</u> to SRO before your new intended last day of stay

Early Withdrawal (2)

Written notice to SRO, example:

- i) Send on <u>1-15 May</u> → liable to pay one-half of Jun hall fee
 - ii) Send on <u>16-31 May</u> → liable to pay full month of Jun hall fee

The last month's lodging fee

- One-half of the monthly hall fee if checking out by 12 noon on the 16th day of the month;
- a full month's hall fee if checking out <u>after</u> 12 noon on the 16th day of the month




















Life in Hall 8 & Jockey Club House
