Klaus is a veterinarian and virologist of international repute. Currently, the Professor of Virology at the Institut für Virologie at the Freie Universität, he is also Adjunct Professor of Virology in the Department of Microbiology and Immunology at Cornell University. His main focus is on herpesvirus pathogenesis and oncogenesis and he uses natural virus-host models for his studies whenever possible. His research has been funded by governmental sources (NIH, USDA, DFG), foundations (Morris Animal Foundation, Harry M. Zweig Memorial Fund) and industry sponsors.
