Dr Roy Kirkwood, originally from the UK, has had an illustrious career in pig health and production spanning several countries. Originally from the UK, he completed his BSc in zoology from the University of Wales before undertaking a PhD programme at the University of Leeds, researching boar effects on gilt puberty. He undertook research in several areas of pig production in New Zealand and Canada before deciding to become a veterinarian. After graduating from Saskatchewan in 1995 with a DVM he moved to Alberta as the provincial swine research veterinarian. He has lectured in pig health and production at the Royal Veterinary College (London), Michigan State University College of Veterinary Medicine and the University of Adelaide (Australia). He is a Diplomate of the European College of Animal Reproduction and is currently an Associate Professor at the School of Animal and Veterinary Science, University of Adelaide.
