About the Speaker

Li Xiao-min, Vice President of the National Judges College, is a researcher, a doctor of law at China University of Political Science and Law, a post-doctoral fellow at the Institute of Law of the Chinese Academy of Social Sciences, a senior visiting scholar at the Law Department of the London School of Economics and Political Science, and has studied at the Institute of Public Administration at the University of Georgia in the United States and the University of Hamburg in Germany. He has worked in the local government and is now mainly responsible for the teaching and supervision of judges, research on trial theory, and applied jurisprudence. His study, which was related to the judicial reform of the Supreme Court of Justice, has been implemented. He has presided over and participated in more than ten national and ministerial-level jurisprudence projects, published more than twenty jurisprudence treatises, and edited and compiled more than 60 jurisprudence books.
